

Neola received the Achiever's Pack, which includes a certificate of achievement, a record holder's ID, and an IBR Medal of achievement.






20th Cycle of Inter School Environmental Public Speaking Competition by EEG

It was a great contest to generate interest in spelling and to motivate students to succeed.




Expressions Galore







UAE Flag Day Celebrations




