



Circular to Parents (Grade 12)

Dear Parent

Greetings!

Please be informed that the registration link for the Emirates Standardized Test (EmSAT) 2021-22, is open to register our students. EmSAT– Achieve test for Grade 12 (2021-2022) is a national system of standardized computer-based tests.

If your ward is interested in taking up EmSAT, she has to submit her valid Emirates ID (Original) to the class teacher on the **4th of October 2021** when she comes to school to write the Unit Test - 2. The original Emirates ID is required for the registration procedure.

Kindly note that registration is **NOT** possible with a photocopy/scanned document of Emirates ID. Please note that the Emirates id can be collected by your ward on the **6th of October 2021**, when she comes to school for her next test.

Following are the details of EmSAT for your reference:

EmSAT Achieve test for Grade 12 is mandatory for the following categories:

- Emirati students in public and private schools (Ministry of Education's curriculum or international curriculum)
- Non-Emirati students in public and private schools that teach Ministry of Education's curriculum
- Emirati and non-Emirati students studying at the Continuing Education Centers - Home Study Track
- Emirati students applying for scholarships outside the country
- **Students who desire to complete their studies at a public or private university in the UAE**
- National service students and applicants to military colleges
- Students under British curriculums in their final academic year - Year 13 (who are listed under the above-mentioned categories)
- Students of international curriculums who need to equalize their certificates

Registration Conditions for EmSAT – Achieve test for Grade 12:

- **EmSAT Achieve Grade 12 is one of the university admission requirements for public/private universities and colleges in the UAE.**
- **EmSAT Achieve Grade 12 is one of the main conditions when applying for scholarships through higher education institutions in the UAE.**
- EmSAT Achieve tests offer the following subjects for all targeted applicants:
 - Mandatory subjects:**
Arabic, English, Math, Physics
 - Other subjects (upon desired major)**
Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science

Fee for the Emirates Standardized Test – Achieve test for Grade 12 is as follows:

- EmSAT website contains all the test specifications, performance levels and test question samples. It also contains the registration process, test rules and policies, test instructions, test calendar and a list of all authorized test centers across the UAE.
- Students will have the opportunity to choose the test dates, locations and timings as well as viewing all results on their **Achieve – Student Portal**.
- It is obligatory for students to thoroughly **read the list of terms and conditions** available on the portal and they will be fully responsible if there are violations.
- Students **must** complete the payment process to confirm their test booking .
- Students now have the option to submit their absence excuses through their portal; once the excuse get accepted the paid amount will be credited to their accounts allowing them to re-book without paying.

- During the current situation of COVID-19: students must adhere to all precautionary and preventive measures mentioned in the student guide on EmSAT website.
- A **negative PCR test result must be provided at the test center for a maximum period of 48 hours** through the Al Hosen/ SEHA app; if one tests positive, it is obligatory to provide 2 consecutive negative results before booking for the test.
