<b>Being Imaginative</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>★ Develop preferences for forms of expression.</li><li>★ Use movement to express feelings.</li><li>★ Create movement in response to music.</li><li>★ Explore colour, texture &amp; shape.</li><li>★ Express and communicate their ideas</li><li>★ Notice what adults do, imitate what is observed and then do it spontaneously when the adult is not there.</li><li>★ Engage in imaginative role – play based on first hand experiences.</li><li>★ Capture experiences and responses with a range of media such as music, dance, paint and other materials in words.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>★ Choose appropriate colour for colouring.</li><li>★ Develop a good colour sense.</li><li>★ Use variety of art media, tools and materials to produce work.</li><li>★ Paint within a given outline.</li><li>★ Create patterns, shapes and collage.</li><li>★ Draw simple pictures.</li><li>★ Recite rhymes and sing songs in tune.</li><li>★ Perform simple movements in rhythmic manner.</li><li>★ Use imagination in art and design, music, dance, imaginative and role play and stories.</li></ul>
