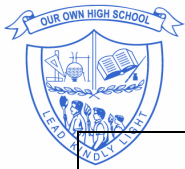




KG2 CURRICULUM – PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Making Relationships	Children will be able to <ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Initiate conversation, attend to and take account of what others say★ Explain own knowledge and understanding and ask appropriate questions of others.★ Take steps to resolve conflicts with other children e.g. making a compromise★ Share with others	Children will <ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Play cooperatively, taking turns with others★ Take account of one another's ideas about how to organize their activity★ Show sensitivity to other's needs and feelings★ Form positive relationships with adults and other children★ Work amicably in a group
Self-confidence and self-awareness	Children will be able to <ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Speak confidently to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions★ describe self in positive terms and talk about abilities	Children will <ul style="list-style-type: none">★ display confidence to try new activities★ say why they like some activities more than others★ speak confidently in a familiar

Managing feelings and behaviour	<p>Children will be able to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Understand that own actions affect other people, for example become upset or try to comfort another child when they realize they have upset them.★ Identify boundaries set and of the behavioral expectations in the setting.★ negotiate and solve problems without aggression e.g. when someone has taken their toy	<p>Children will</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">★ Talk about how they and others show feelings.★ Talk about their own and other's behavior and its consequences.★ Know that some behavior is unacceptable.★ Work as part of a group or class and understand or follow the rules.★ Adjust their behavior to different situations and take changes of routine in their stride
