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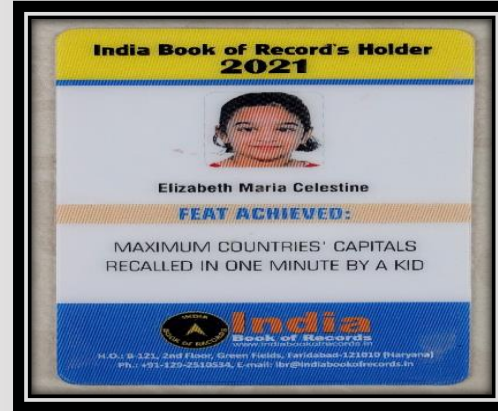
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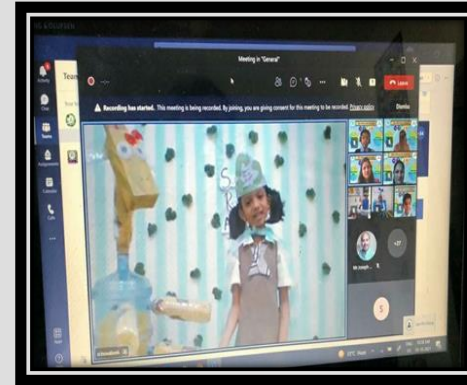
# STUDENT ACHIEVEMENTS

## CALLISTHENIC DRILL



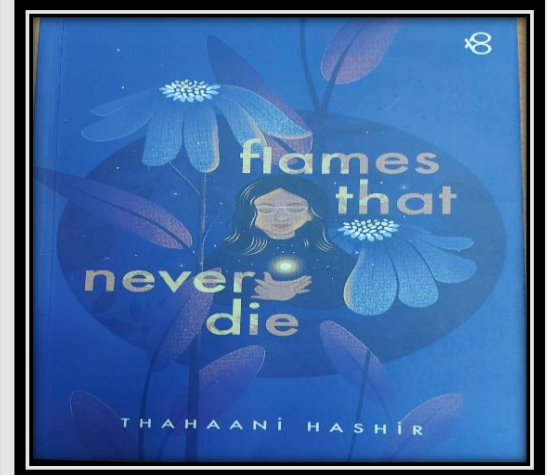



The judges will choose a few teams as finalists to give an in-person presentation to a panel of judges on November 8<sup>th</sup>.

Once the project is submitted, a panel of judges will review each video and written paper to score it for clarity of scientific content and technical accuracy.

On October 3<sup>rd</sup>, teams will videotape their machine in action and submit the video, along with a one-page written explanation of the science behind the workings of the machine.

During the project proposal stage, teams are required to present their main ideas, along with a drawing of their prototype.

The project proposal will take place on the 30<sup>th</sup> of June.

**BUDDING POETESS OF OOS**

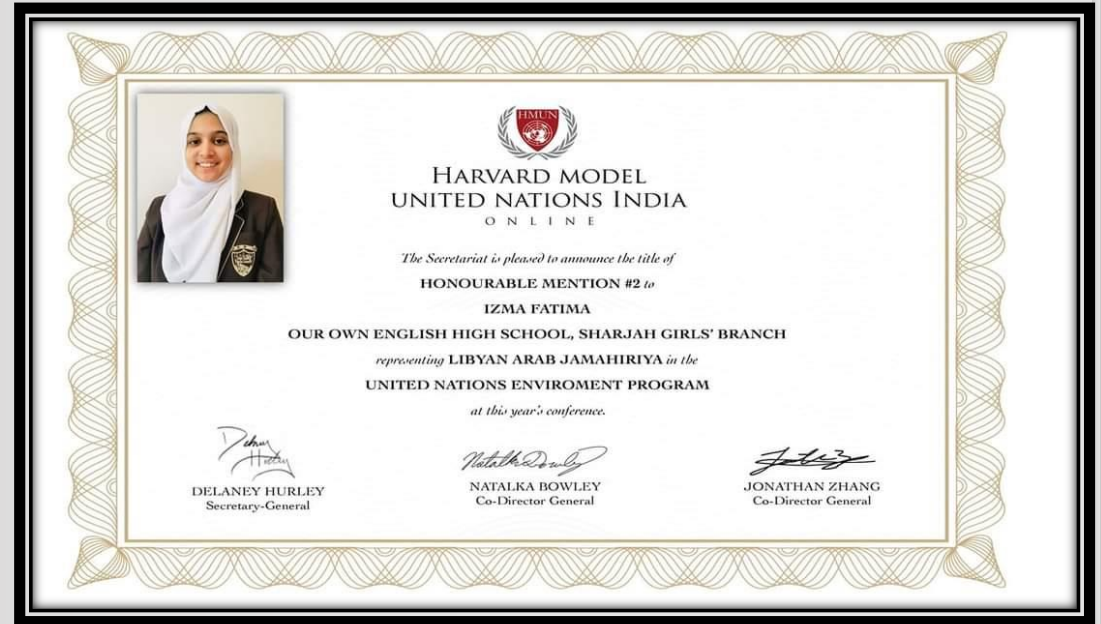

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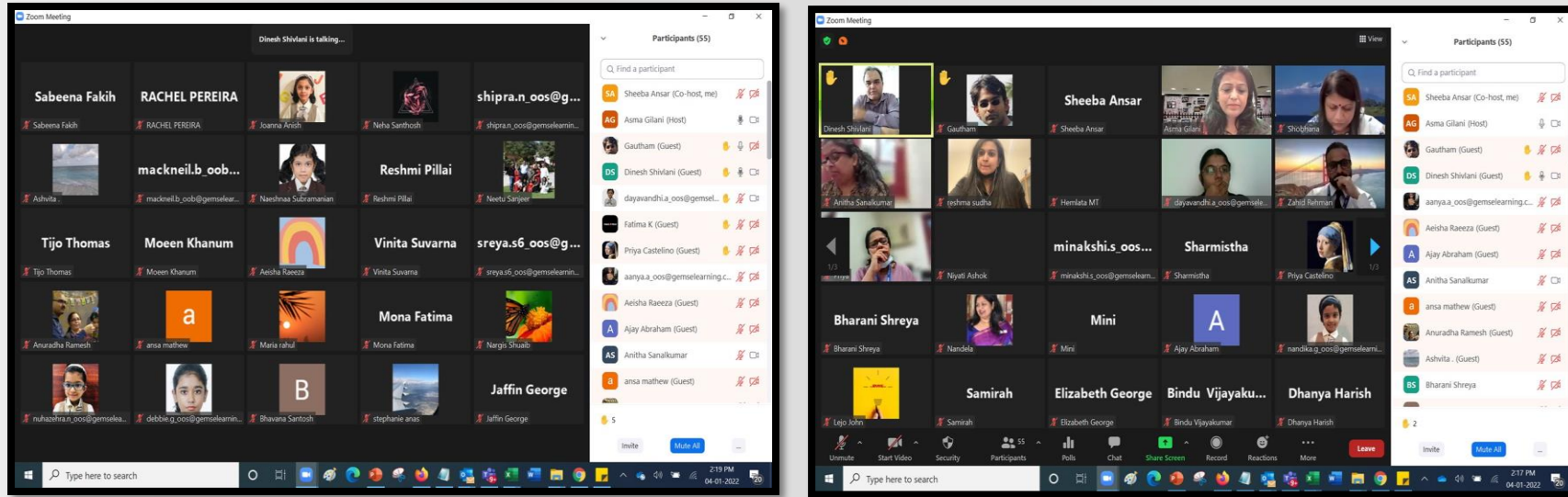
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# SCHOOL EVENTS

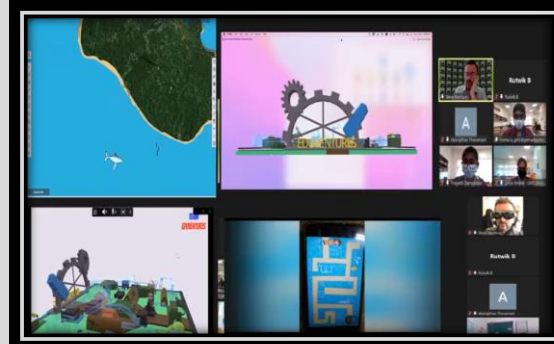
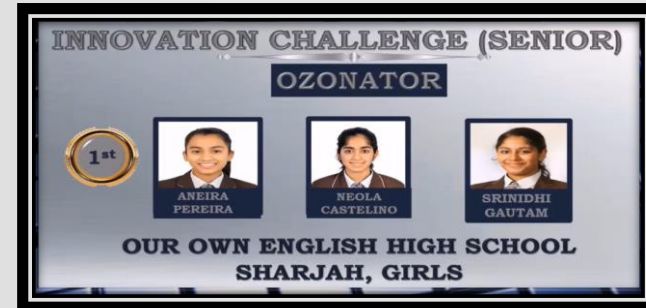
## UAE- YEAR OF 50<sup>TH</sup> - CELEBRATING THE GLORIOUS JOURNEY

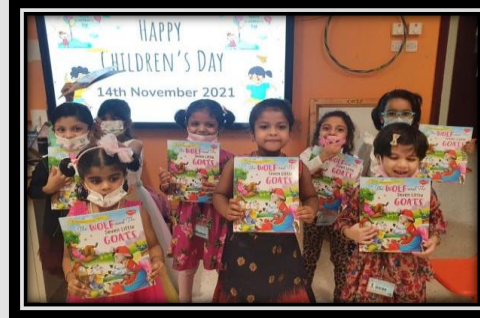
## THE GLORIOUS 50 – KG2 SPORTS DAY

World Children's Day was observed on the 21<sup>st</sup> of November to raise awareness and support children's welfare across the globe.

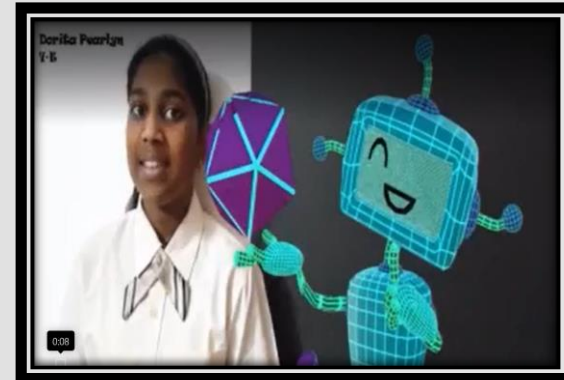
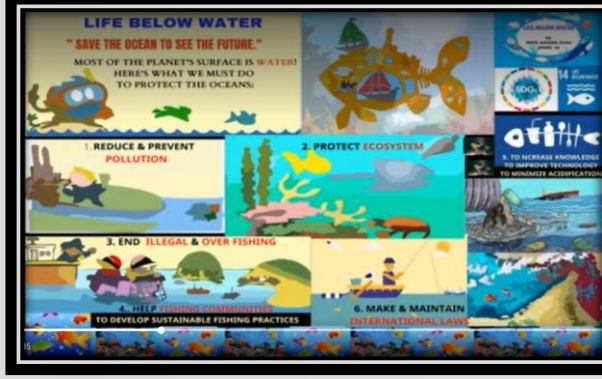


## UAE FLAG DAY CELEBRATION

## SECOND LANGUAGE WEEK



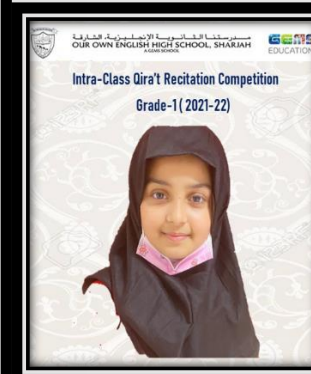
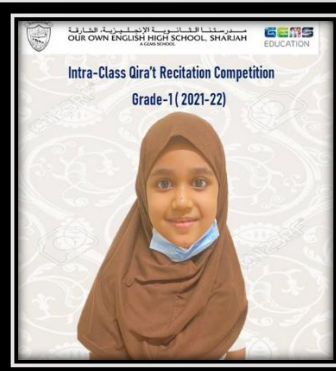

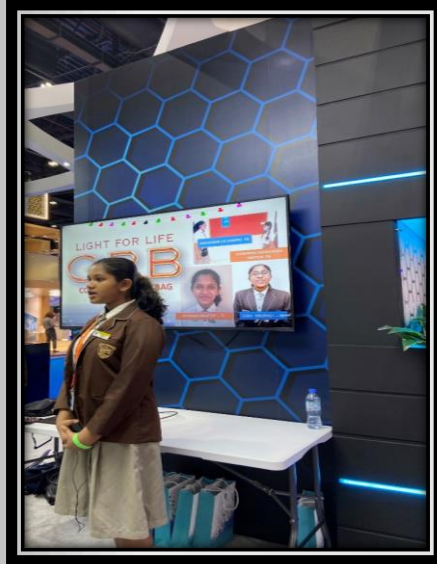
**ANNUAL ATHLETIC MEET 2021**

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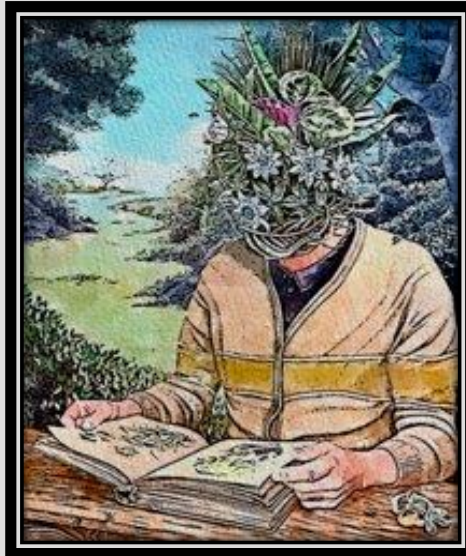

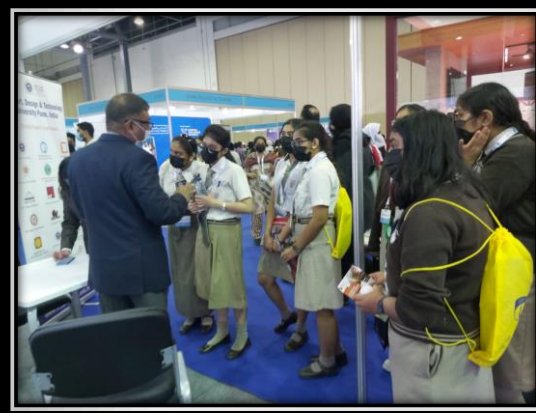
## PICTURESQUE-2021

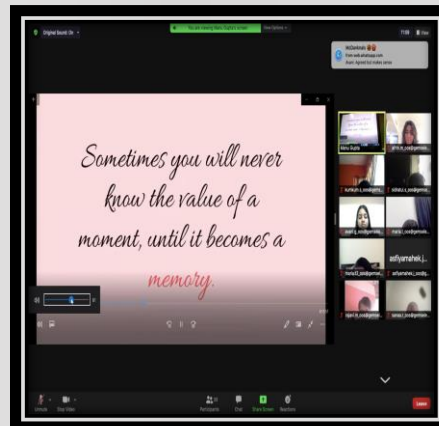
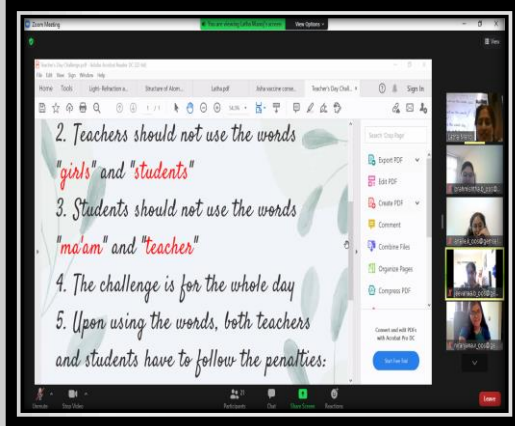


## INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION SHOW

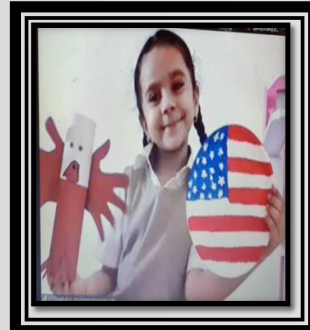

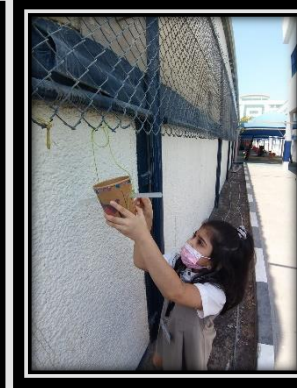
The tiny-tots with great curiosity, ingenuity and fervor created models using recycled materials related to the facts they learned about the “**Land of Dreams- USA**”.

## ORGANIC BIRD FEEDER

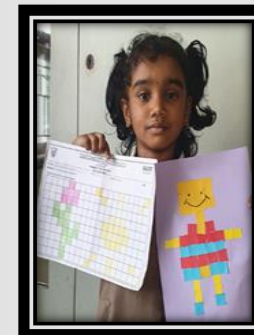

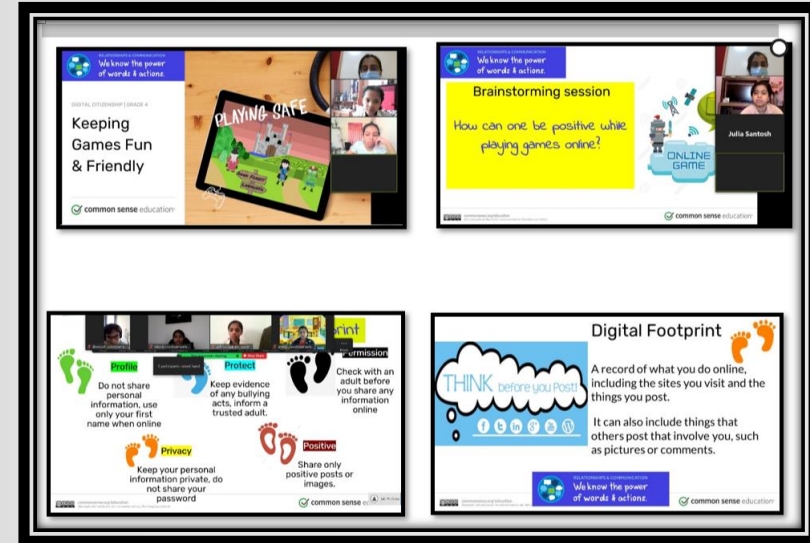
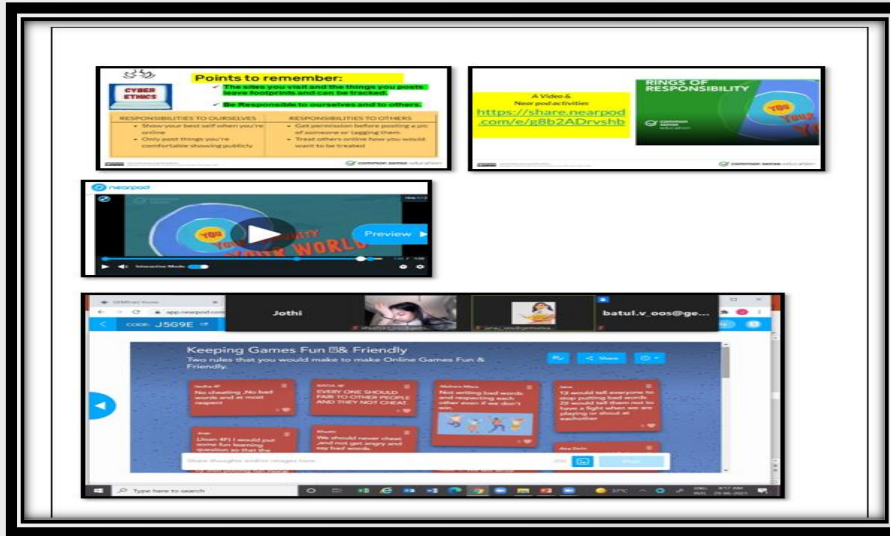
**TALENT WEEK- PRIMARY**

Students celebrated Children's day on 11th November 2021 making it a bookless day and students came in coloured attires. The teachers left no stones unturned to make the day memorable for the students.

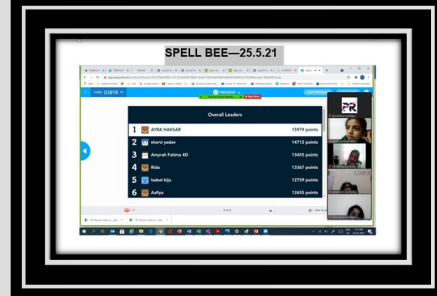
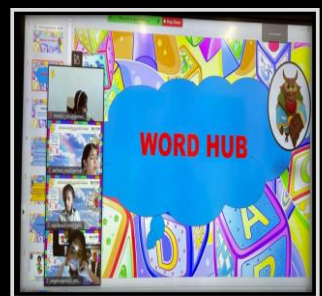

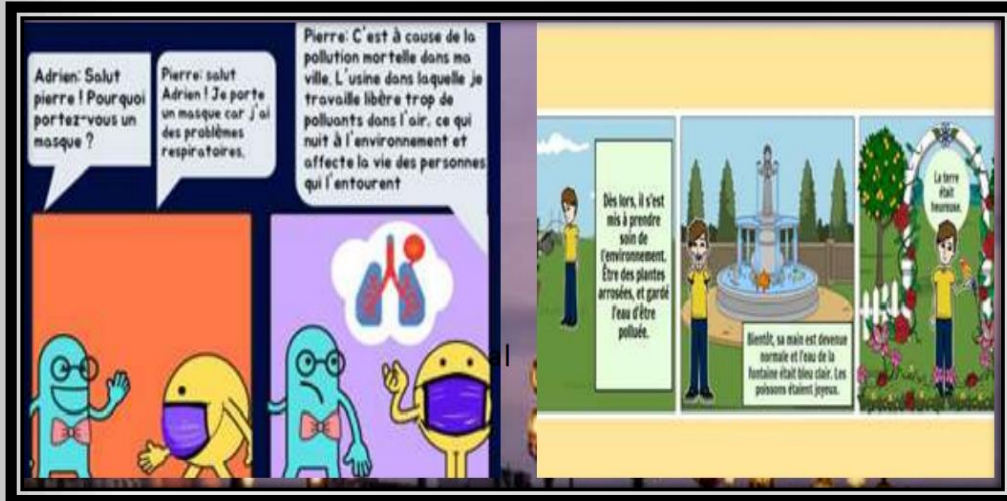
## PERCEPTIONS

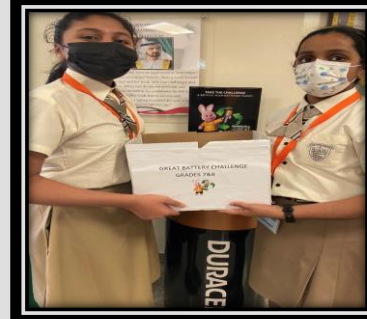


## TREASURES UNTOLD

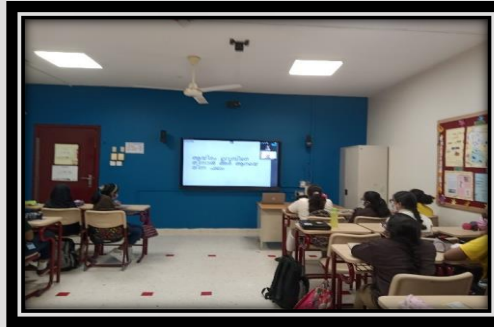
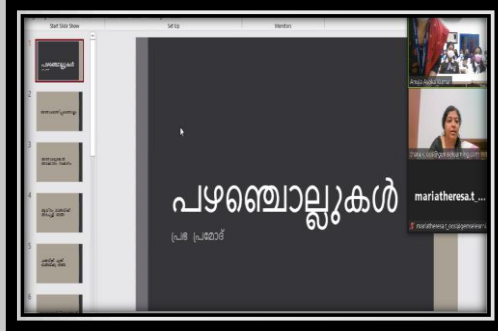
## PARENT TALK

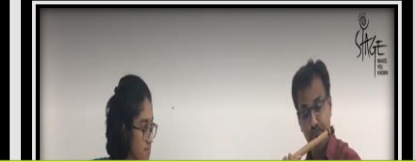
