Subject-SPEA guidelines for rejoining school after the summer break

Dear Parents,

I hope this email finds you well and safe.

Please find below the latest guidelines received from SPEA regarding rejoining school after the summer break:

- COVID-19 PCR testing is mandatory for students (age 12 and above). Validity of the PCR test must not exceed 96 hours (4 days)
Kindly upload the PCR test results in the Parent portal-GEMS Connect and also send a copy to the respective class teacher.
- Rejoining school will not be permissible for those who have not completed the isolation period and received a “De-isolation Certificate” from the approved health authority in the Emirate, in the event of contracting the virus in the period immediately preceding the rejoining date.
- Compliance with the “stay at home if you are not feeling well” policy should be ensured for those who have any symptoms related to COVID-19. Rejoining the school is only permitted after the symptoms are no longer present and a negative PCR test result is obtained.

School Visits Procedures

1. To enter the school, all visitors are required to present a green pass on “Al Hosn” application.
2. Anyone with high temperature (37 degrees C and above) must not come to school.
